CALL FOR SUBMISSIONS

This Spring the Psi-Eta chapter of Phi Alpha Theta in association with the University of North Florida's Department of History will host its 8th annual history conference. This year we hope to collaborate with local historical societies and groups like the Jacksonville Historical Society to offer a larger conference spanning multiple disciplines. The event will kick off March 24th, with a reception at Old Saint Andrews Church in Downtown Jacksonville, and will be followed by a two day conference hosted at the University of North Florida.

We invite submissions from undergraduate and graduate students, as well as members of local historical groups, who are interested in sharing their personal research or current projects. Presenters are encouraged to submit individual papers or panel proposals. Paper presentations should not exceed fifteen minutes in length and should revolve around history, anthropology, philosophy, political science, etc.

Those wishing to present a single paper should send an abstract of no more than 200 words to unfpatconference@gmail.com attached as an MS Word document or pdf. Submissions for panels should include a brief abstract of each paper included in the group. Historical associations should send a project outline (if applicable).
