We hope to receive hundreds of letters from different corners of the world or, as we say, “different shores of memory,” sensitive letters for the heart, which have long inhabited in the silence. We need to say again what has not been said enough — the metaphor of sacrifice. Narrating what has not been said is the way to come back together, to return to the small stories, the lived stories, the stories that cut through your body, those that are not in the great books of history.

On October 16, as part of the commemoration of the 19 years since Operation Orion, we will deliver to Comuna 13 thousands or millions of letters that speak to a common sentiment. In addition, in response to the letters, we will deliver a hip-hop music video with stories from the organizations of La Red Territorial de la Memoria Comuna 13, Medellín.

On the National Day of Victims in Colombia, April 9, 2022, residents of Comuna 13 will reply to the letters received.
